Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is a "cooperative"?

A. A cooperative, or "co-op", is a collaborative organization that is jointly staffed by all of our members. At "First Class Chilliwack" FCCH, we count on all of our members to contribute their time, energy and talents by helping implement our programs, events and activities. The co-op has a Board of Directors who oversee the ministry and offer help and support where needed.

Q. Do I need a membership? Yes-The membership registration is divided in two parts, the online membership registration that goes towards the support from First Class Homeschool Ministries.

And the local co-op registration that goes towards the general operation of the co-op.

Online membership \$25 US.(see details online)

Local co-op registration due on registration day \$20.00 CAN

Tuition: \$3.00/class, per child supply fee may be added. (Depending on the class)



Q: Are parents required to teach at FCCH?

No, but they are required to stay on campus and will be assigned a "job" somewhere during class hours. Of course, we strongly encourage parents to teach, it's what it makes FCCH to offer so much!

Each parent will have a one hour break; this will give time to meet new people.

Q. When does FCCH operate?

Typically, 8-10 week sessions, September-November, and again on March-early May.

Q. What should I do if I can't afford to participate?

Q. What types of events and activities are available through First Class Chilliwack?

A. Our activities and events are as varied as our members. It's all up to you! In the past, First Class families have enjoyed a wide range of classes and activities ranging from Crafts, sports, unit studies to Foreign Language classes, picnics etc.

Q. How is a day at FCCH?

We have 2 blocks of activities. When register, every student must list 3 class choices per block of class. If the child's first choice is not available they will be assigned their second choice and so on.

At the end of the day, all participants and leaders are committed to clean up.
