



First Class Fee Breakdown

FCHM National Membership Fee:

\$25 per Year. Once your membership fee is paid, you can participate in any First Class Co-op in your area. Your FCHM membership fee is used to pay for operating costs, member benefits and scholarships for those with financial hardships.

Local Co-op Registration Fees:

\$25 per family paid yearly and covers the fall and spring semesters.

These dues allow your co-op to pay general operating costs and give scholarships to homeschool families in need.

Local Co-op Class Fees:

Base Class Fee - \$3 per class (Helps pay for basic things such as paper, pencils, markers, glue etc to run classes). This money goes to the local co-op

Supply Fee - Varies per class (Pays for extra supplies unique to that class). This fee is determined by the parent teaching the class. We ask that teachers keep fees to a minimum. None of the fees go to the parent teacher but to pay for items needed for the class. However, if there is interest in a class that does cost more that is fine. Exceptions would be if a group of parents wanted to bring in a teacher for a specific class that no one has the ability to teach such as fencing, chemistry, advanced guitar, Lego robotics etc.
